Switching To Electric Tax Credit

A tax credit provided as it relates to the sales of electric cars by car dealerships.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Definitions

"Electric Car." A car fully powered by an electric battery cell that does not have any capacity to utilize gas fuel.

Section 2. Tax Credit

- (a) A tax credit shall be awarded to car dealerships as follows:
  - (1) The car dealership must sell electric cars;
    - (i) The tax credit may only be applied to taxation on electric vehicles, not on the taxes of the entirety of the dealership;

- (2) A quota system shall be established in order to determine the size of a tax credit warranted to the dealership;
  - (i) The Department of Transportation shall be responsible for surveying each dealership and determining the appropriate quota for each level of tax break;
  - (ii) The more electric cars a dealership sells the larger tax credit they will be eligible for.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
