Mandatory Extra-Curricular Involvement Act

Requirements as it relates to high school students' involvement in extra-curricular activities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Required Involvement.

- (a) Public school districts shall be permitted 24 months to enact the following:
 - (1) An expansion of after school activities;
 - (i) Incentivization to expand teachers role in sponsorship of after school activities;
 - (a) Proper compensation shall be determined by the school board factoring in time requirements, effort, expertise, and demand;

- (ii) It shall become a requirement that a minimum of half of high school teachers be required to sponsor one after school activity;
- (2) An application process for unoffered programs;
 - (i) To provide options and input, as sought by students, in the expansion of activities offered through the school;
- (3) Students are required to participate in, at minimum, 2 extra-curricular activities each school year.
- (i) This shall become a graduation requirement

 Section 2. This act shall go into effect on June 1, 2024.
