Artificial Intelligence Ban in K–12 Schools Act

This law is called the “Artificial Intelligence Ban in K–12 Schools Act.”

Schools may not use AI for teaching, grading, testing, or creating lessons. Students may not use AI to do homework, projects or tests. Teachers and staff may not use AI to grade work or write materials for students.

This law does not apply to:

- Tools used only for security or school operations.
- Technology required by federal law for students with disabilities, if it doesn’t do their work for them.
- State testing systems that do not use AI to grade or create content.

The Department of Education will make reasonable rules and check compliance. Schools that break this law may lose funding or pay fines up to \$5,000 per violation.

This law starts 90 days after it is passed.
